Project name	MOVE - Mobility Oriented to Volunteering and Empowerment
Short Project Description	<p>"MOVE" aims to promote mobility and transnational volunteering as non-traditional form of emancipation and learning, aimed in particular at young people with fewer opportunities will be directly or indirectly involved, in order to obtain a better knowledge of the active role that they can play in the communities of origin, and more generally in society, for a transition to adulthood and the responsibilities that this entails, more harmonious and conscious.</p> <p>The project will involve 10 volunteers from Spain, Germany, France, Portugal, Austria, Czech Republic, Greece, Croatia, Poland, Bulgaria. They are young people between 18 and 26 years old who have decided to take a "gap year in order to acquire more valuable skills for a future job or course of study, or because bewildered, with the expectation of finding their own way, making, in the meantime, a valuable experience abroad.</p> <p>MOVE consists of 5 EVS in hospitality at CSC, Municipality of Anzola, Center Montanari, YouNet, City of Budrio, all organizations working in the Bologna metropolitan area.</p>

Contest and environment	 <p>Budrio is a small Municipality close to Bologna 15 minutes by train.</p> <p>The project includes the involvement of volunteers in the cultural activities of the Municipality of Budrio, with particular attention to those related to the Theatre Consortium, the Water Towers, the Ocarina Museum, to the Puppet and cured initiatives by the Department of Youth Policy, in order to develop stronger relationships and dynamics between the different cultural initiatives of Budrio, including educational institutions, and promote cultural initiatives for citizenship, with particular attention to young people. Promotional activities will be organized, such as cultural events, courses, workshops, exhibitions, book presentations, guided tours offered by the municipality of Budrio, including through social networks and websites of the Municipality in collaboration with the Communication Group (composed by local youth). The project will be organized with an initial period of non- formal education and knowledge of the multiple possibilities of cultural production in the area, to allow the volunteers to acquire the skills needed in a concrete autonomous contribution. Among the various activities that can be undertaken, volunteers will be also involved in theatrical activities at schools or activate language in art workshops at the library involving children and young people of the Municipality.</p> <p>Also, being in contact with the local people, volunteers can be totally immerse in the Italian and local culture, learning customs, traditions and uses.</p> <p>Previous experience in the field of entertainment, communication and some technical knowledge about Theatre, would also give us an interesting opportunity for sharing best practices. Volunteers needs to bring his/her own laptop</p> <p>All together, volunteers will develop some common projects (supported by the mentor), for example the VIDEO about MOVE, radio interviews, public language tandems, public events...</p> <p>All volunteers have the responsibility to contribute to the visibility of the project and of the Erasmus+ programme</p>

Accommodation description	The accommodation is the guest house (attic) of the Municipality. Volunteer will have a single/double room (bed linens and blankets are provided), shared toilet (we suggest you to bring your own towels). From time to time, depending on particular local events, other guests can be hosted in the accommodation. Each room has its own key and the privacy of each person will be respected.
Food allowance	Volunteer will receive a food money of 150€
Local Transport	Volunteer will have the bus ticket for activities, if needed
Pocket money	4€ per day
Closest airport/travel direction	Bologna is the closest airport. Volunteer can also land at the airport of Milan, Venice, Rome and then take a train to Bologna. From Bologna the volunteer can take a regional train, available every 20 minutes.
Language training	<p>Volunteers are really welcome to learn Italian before and during their service. After filling it, each volunteer will receive another email to start the on line course provided by Erasmus+ program (http://erasmusplusols.eu/).</p> <p>OLS will be the official tool to use to learn Italian during the EVS. If needed, at the beginning YouNet can provide an additional training with an Italian teacher for a couple of months.</p> <p>Two weeks before the end of the EVS each volunteer will receive an email with the final linguistic test to fill, in order to receive the final level of Italian.</p>
