VOLUNTEERS TASKS AND RESPONSIBILTIES

- Communication with international students and foreign partners;
- Support in reorganizing the database, documentation, and promotional materials;
- Assistance in organizing international events, including conferences, seminars and training sessions;
- Updating information on the website, social media and YouTube channels, organizing social media campaigns;
- Promoting the office's activities within the academic community and beyond;
- Active participation in organizing student events, especially for international students;
- Co-organizing intercultural meetings and promoting student mobility;
- Preparing short films, photo reportages featuring students on exchange.

Volunteering hours are 35 hours per week (6 hours per day in host org. + 5 extra hours per week for planning activities for local events) that promote the project and the European Solidarity Corps.

PRACTICAL ARRANGMENTS





- Polish language course (twice a week, 4 school hours).
- Obligatory on-arrival and mid-term trainning in Poland.
- Trainings in our office to suppot adaptiation, task performing, health and safety training at the beginning of the project.
- Tasks related trainings with IRO staff or specialist according to volunteers needs.



- Monthly pocket money-150 EUR a month.
- Food money- 650 PLN amonth. This money is enough to buy basic food to cook at home, not to go torestaurants.
- Reimbursement of the travel costs from the city of origin to Wroclaw and back (up to the amount based on the ESC Distance Calculator, the excessive amount will be paid by the participant).
- Local transportation card (for trams, buses and night uses).
- Health and liability insurance.



- Place in a double room in a flat shared with other participants orstudents (with Internet access, equipped kitchen. The flats have a "student standard".
- Mentor's support throughout the entire project.
- Support of a special mentor and additional support (e.g. psychologist) for participants who experience various obstacles in their lives.
