Description			
<i>Provide a short description of the event and its activities.</i>			
<p>Throughout the WORTH project, each partner organization dedicated significant efforts to disseminate the project's results in their respective countries. Utilizing a variety of online and offline channels, the project aimed to raise awareness and share the stories of women in resistance during the 20th century. An important component of the dissemination strategy was the organization of dissemination events, which took place in May 2024 across partner countries including Italy, Romania, Slovenia, Poland, and Portugal. These events served as key platforms for presenting the project's outcomes, fostering dialogue, and engaging with local communities to honor the legacy of courageous women who shaped history through their acts of resistance.</p> <p>Dissemination event in Novo Mesto, Slovenia</p> <p>On May 8, 2024, DRPDNM organized a dissemination event in Novo Mesto, which gathered 30 participants. The event served as a platform to present the results of the WORTH project, including the outcomes of the Human Library and Urban Trekking events organized in Novo Mesto.</p> <p>During the session, participants had the opportunity to view the video testimonies of the Living Books recorded in Slovenia, offering a firsthand glimpse into the experiences and stories shared during the project. The event provided valuable insights into the project's achievements and contributions to preserving and disseminating the stories of women in resistance throughout the 20th century.</p> <p>Dissemination event in Poland, Wroclaw</p> <p>On May 14, 2024, DFOP organized a dissemination event at Centrum na Przedmiesciu in Wroclaw, Poland. The event attracted a 35 participants eager to learn about the stories of Ukrainian women who participated as Human Books in the Human Library Event. These stories resonated deeply with the experiences of Polish women involved in resistance movements during the conflicts of the 20th century, including World War II and the subsequent communist era.</p> <p>In addition to sharing these compelling narratives, the event also showcased the results of the WORTH project. Attendees had the opportunity to view photos from the Human Library, Urban Trekking, and key international events such as the commemoration day in Romania and the Final conference in Italy.</p> <p>Dissemination event in Bologna, Italy</p> <p>On May 24, 2024, a dissemination event was held in the presentation room of YouNet's office in Bologna, Italy. The event attracted a diverse audience, including European Solidarity Corps volunteers from various EU countries and beyond.</p> <p>26 attendees gathered to learn about the WORTH project, its objectives, and key outcomes. The event featured video testimonies recorded with members of ANPI Bologna (the National Association of the Italian Partisans), shedding light on the experiences of Italian women partisans during the 20th century.</p> <p>Additionally, highlights from international events such as the commemoration day in Romania and the final conference in Italy were shared. Participants also had the opportunity to hear feedback from those who participated in the Human Library event and Urban Trekking held in Bologna.</p> <p>The event concluded with a lively debate on the role of women in resistance movements and their enduring influence on contemporary European society. Discussions also emphasized the significance of remembrance events in the context of modern-day conflicts worldwide.</p> <p>Dissemination event in Guimarães, Portugal</p> <p>On 28 May, the Fraterna auditorium hosted a dissemination activity in collaboration with the Day Centre. The event began with a detailed presentation about the WORTH project, explaining its essence and the activities developed throughout its execution. The WORTH project aims to preserve and disseminate the memories and stories of women in Portugal who lived and fought during the Salazar dictatorship, highlighting their resilience and courage.</p> <p>Following the introduction to the project, videos featuring the testimonies of five women who contributed their stories to WORTH were shown. Each of them shared the difficulties and challenges they faced during Salazar's regime, providing participants with a deep and personal insight into the struggles for freedom and justice of that time.</p> <p>The session was followed by a small debate, where everyone present had the opportunity to ask questions and share their own experiences lived during the dictatorial period. The moment of exchange was enriching and provided a collective reflection on the past, highlighting the importance of historical memory in building a fairer future.</p> <p>The event concluded with several accolades for the WORTH project. Many participants expressed their</p>			

appreciation for the initiative and requested more projects and similar activities that promote the preservation of memory and the valuing of stories of struggle and resistance. The dissemination activity at the Fraterna auditorium not only achieved its objective of informing and raising awareness but also strengthened community ties and underscored the importance of collective memory.

The event in Portugal gathered 27 participants.

Dissemination event in Brasov, Romania

The dissemination event organized by UniTBv took place over two days, 28-29 May 2024, and gathered 75 participants. The event was carried out in two stages. The first stage was held at the Apollonia Cultural Centre in Braşov, as part of the public presentation of the research projects of the Digital Media students from the Faculty of Sociology and Communication. During this session, images from the 2023 event commemorating the women of the 20th-century resistance movements, fragments from the Human Library recordings, and images from the Gamified Urban Trekking were presented.

The second stage of the dissemination event repeated the presentation during a working meeting of the Department of Social and Communication Sciences of the Faculty of Sociology and Communication. This session included members of the department and their guests.

All participants were informed that excerpts from the Human Library recordings are available on the website of the Faculty of Sociology and Communication, UniTBv.

Following the events, all participants were provided with essential project data and a link to access the EUSurvey platform.
