Work & festivities is a volunteering team project. A team of 10 volunteers will work together with the local community to create activities and increase involvement. Tasks include eg.

- planning and implementing activities with local residents
- creating and participating in communal and cultural events
- maintenance of the outdoor venues (parks, playgrounds etc)

During the project, Siikajoki hosts a multi-day festival for everyone. The programme is created by local actors. Volunteers will have an opportunity to carry out own ideas during the festival.

Accommodation, food and transportation arrangements

Volunteers are accommodated in a dormitory in shared rooms. Volunteers need to cook for themselves (food allowance and pocket money will be provided). Within the village the distances are short. If needed, transportation is provided. Train station with connections to other cities locate within short distance.

Mandatory costs are covered according to programme rules.

Training

Volunteers will participate in on-arrival training. Task related support and mentoring will be provided.

Volunteer profile

We would like to receive active volunteers who are motivated to work together with local community. Some tasks are done outdoors so volunteers need to be prepared to work despite the weather. Working hours will change according to tasks, so volunteers need to be flexible.
