




Prepare Polish traditional dishes!

- Insurance - make sure you have an European Health Insurance Card, although you will be provided by Cigna Insurance
- Travel costs - we will reimburse you the travel cost, up to the budget limits according to the distance





- Boarding money - food and cleaning - 20 PLN/ per day
- Pocket money - each volunteer will receive 120,00 EUR monthly
- Local transport - you will have covered transportation card - day/night buses and trams
- Polish SIM - we will give you polish SIM card for your mobile phone
- Accommodation - volunteers will be accommodated in the most appropriate place for this project

Let's spread the merry singing in Polish schools, local community and all over Europe!







