Who are we?

Educational Trip Foundation, which is the coordinator of the whole project, is an NGO supporting the education of young people and developing cultural activities in smaller towns.

During its two years of activity, it has successfully implemented many mobility projects for students of vocational and technical schools. They also cooperate with local authorities in the implementation of artistic workshops for children. This year we have decided to expand our activities with the European Voluntary Service. We support two institutions - the Communal Cultural Centre and the School and Kindergarten Complex.

- Community Cultural Centre - 4 volunteers


What will you be doing?

• School and Kindergarten Team

- teaching children aged 3-6 (kindergarten) and older (elementary school),
- helping the teacher with daily tasks,
- organizing games and activities from your country,
- teaching English to children,
- promoting multiculturalism,
- leading activities to introduce the culture of your country,
- lots of space for your ideas!

• Community Cultural Center:

- cooperation in artistic workshops (dance, ceramics, art and others)
- Support in the implementation of events (Harvest Festival, historical picnic, half-school for children)
- Language workshops for employees and residents of the village,
- workshops promoting volunteerism,
- meetings with your culture,
- plenty of space for your ideas!



PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

Where will you live?

All volunteers (there will be 8 of you) will live in a shared house.

- Double rooms - each about 20m2.
- Two kitchens
- Two bathrooms
- Common room
- Garden

We want your shared apartment to be an important part of the project as well. Let's show that it is possible to live in harmony under one roof and create a unique intercultural community.

An important aspect will also be taking care of the shared house!

What do we provide?

- We cover the costs of compulsory tests on Covid-19
- pocket money
- covering transport costs (up to a certain amount)
- insurance
- accommodation
- support from coordinators and a mentor
- training necessary to work
