T4.2	3D scanning of objects connected to WWII in Rezekne, Latvia	The objective of this activity is to conduct 3D scanning of objects that are directly connected to WWII period, stories of women and children in the city of Rezekne. The task will be managed by Spark in collaboration with WOH, and it will be done in 2 steps: 1. Identification of Objects: the first step is identification of at least 3 objects connected to the topic of the project and history of WWII 2. 3D Scanning – expert from Spark will take care of the 3D scanning of the identified objects to capture the physical characteristics, textures, and dimensions of the objects ensuring a detailed representation. 3D scanning process will be done after the local commemoration event in Rezekne, in which 2 experts from Spark will participate.
